COMPETITION FOR THE ALLOCATION OF MONETARY GRANTS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE SCUOLA DI MUSICA DI FIESOLE FOR THE 2020/2021 ACADEMIC YEAR

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 15th JANUARY 2021 (extended to 21/01/2021)

ART. 1 – Purpose of competition and grant amounts

The Scuola di Musica di Fiesole non-profit Foundation is holding a competition to award a maximum of **15 (fifteen)** grants in the amount of € **500,00 each** (gross amount before required taxes to be withheld), for those students in difficult financial conditions, to enable them to continue their studies.

The increase in the number of contributions made by the School for this academic year 2020-21 demonstrates the interest of the School to consider the critical issues related to the pandemic caused by the COVID-19 coronavirus. For the same reason, students who got the same grant last academic year 2019/20 can also participate in the competition to the assignment of the grant for financial difficulties this year too.

ART. 2 – Recipients

The above-mentioned grants are intended for students in financial difficulty and/or extremely serious family situations. Only one economical support will be assigned for each family (even if more students belong to it)

Students enrolled for the Academic Year 2020/2021 may apply for these grants.

Students who didn't pay the registration fee for 2020/21 will be not admitted to the **economic support**.

ART. 3 – Requirements

In order to participate in the competition the student must meet **all requirements** listed below, by the application deadline:

- a) be enrolled in Scuola di Musica di Fiesole
- b) meet the following requirement regarding economic conditions:
 - ISEE less than or equal to € 20.000,00;
- c) not be awarded a scholarship for the Academic Year 2020-21.

The ISEE certification must be valid or expiring on 31/12/2020. ISEE calculation can be processed at all INPS offices, City Hall offices or CAF offices.

Foreign students who are not resident in Italy must submit a self-certification accompanied by the documentation relating to the economic and patrimonial conditions issued by the competent authorities in which the income was produced and where the assets are owned.

d) find themselves in one of the following serious situations (this list is merely illustrative and not exhaustive):

a. serious economic difficulties as a result of events such as job loss (unemployment, layoffs, bankruptcy, dismissal, etc.), death of the main income earner (with reference to the members of the entire household), the birth of a child or other life-changing events (these indications are intended to be merely illustrative and not exhaustive);

b. serious diseases that have affected the student or a member of the student's family, which in turn have affected the student's academic studies;

c. serious difficulties as a result of earthquakes or other natural disasters that have affected the student or his/her family.

Only those situations arising from events that occurred over the past two years, or were still in effect during the same time period, will be taken into consideration.

The application must be accompanied by appropriate documentation to support these statements. In the event of serious diseases affecting the student or a family member, appropriate certification, issued by the National Health Service or a specialist, must be provided.

ART. 4 – Presentation of applications

The application for participation in the competition, written on plain paper or by using the form available on the School website: <http://www.scuolamusicafiesole.it/it/didattica/borse-di-studio>, must be presented to the Academic Office by email: segrdidattica@scuolamusicafiesole.fi.it

The deadline for submission of applications is 15th JANUARY 2021.

The application must be accompanied by all documentation providing financial difficulty, as indicated in Art. 3.

Applications lacking the above-mentioned documentation or submitted with incomplete information by the deadline will not be taken into consideration.

ART. 5 – Grant allocation

Grants will be awarded after consideration by the School Directors, whose decisions are final. They will assess all financially difficult situations, also taking into account the student's academic progress.

ART. 6 – Grant distribution

The Academic Office will individually inform all participants about the results of the competition by e-mail, at the address indicated on the application form. The grant will be deducted in total or in part from the current cost of the annual tuition fee. If there will be no more shares of the fee, the grant will be transferred by wire to the bank account indicated in the form.

ART. 7 – Personal data

Personal information provided with the application for participation in the competition will be treated in compliance with the right to protection of personal data under Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 n.196.

The data will be used exclusively for purposes related to this competition. Processing will be done both electronically and on paper.

The provision of data is compulsory and any refusal may result in exclusion from the competition.
